A \*notarized copy of my graduation certificate from a Canadian Council for Accreditation of Pharmacy Programs (CCAPP) approved pharmacy technician training program, or, confirmation of successful completion of the Pharmacy Examining Board of Canada (PEBC) Pharmacy Technician Evaluating Examination and Technician Bridging Program as approved by Council.
  5. An original signed declaration that I have read and understand the fluency requirements for a pharmacy technician, as listed on the College website, and that I have:
    - a. Provided language proficiency test results (sent directly to the College from an approved assessment centre) that meet the NAPRA Language Proficiency Requirements for Licensure as a Pharmacy Technician in Canada; or
    - b. Provided a \*notarized copy of my transcript confirming graduation from a high school in Canada with three consecutive, first language English or French courses/credits; or
    - c. Provided a \*notarized copy of my transcript confirming graduation from a Collège d'enseignement général et professionnel (CEGEP) in Quebec with three consecutive, first language English or French courses/credits; or
    - d. Provided a \*notarized copy of my transcript or degree confirming graduation with an undergraduate degree from a university in Canada, whose instruction was provided in English or French.
  6. An original signed declaration that I do not suffer from a physical or mental condition, including an addiction to alcohol or drugs, that may interfere with my ability to work in training in a safe and effective manner.
