MOTION #2: MOVED BY KURT SCHROEDER, SECONDED BY TODD MERENIUK THAT Council approved a College position statement on the sale and advertising of cannabis for non-medical (recreational) use to include the following statements:

- i. Pharmacies must not sell cannabis for non-medical (recreational) use
- ii. Pharmacists and pharmacy technicians must not promote cannabis for non-medical (recreational) use.
- iii. Information promoting the use of cannabis must not be displayed or posted in a pharmacy; including the dispensary, professional products department, or areas where other health products are stored.
- iv. Cannabis must not be sold or promoted in an establishment where goods or services are sold or offered for sale to the public if:
 - i. a pharmacy is located within the establishment, or
 - ii. customers of a pharmacy can enter into the establishment directly or by the use of a corridor or area used exclusively to connect the pharmacy with the establishment.
