Practice Consultant (Term Position)

The College of Pharmacists of Manitoba (College) has an opening for a one year term, 0.8 FTE (30 hours/week) Practice Consultant.

This position requires that applicants be a licensed pharmacist with practice experience and a strong knowledge of pharmacy practice legislation and standards, quality assurance processes and key patient safety concepts.

The College is the licensing and regulatory body for the practice of pharmacy in Manitoba. The primary role is the protection of the public through the regulation of pharmacy practice. The College has fulfilled this mandate since 1878 and has received both national and international recognition for the activities in support of that mandate. The mission of the College is “To protect the health and well-being of the public by ensuring and promoting safe, patient-centred and progressive pharmacy practice in collaboration with other health-care providers.”

Reporting to the Deputy Registrar, the Practice Consultant is an integral member of the College team. The successful candidate will participate in the administration and oversight of the Continuous Professional Development Program and ensuring qualification of applicants seeking licensure to practice pharmacy in Manitoba.

Duties will include representing the College on independent and collaborative initiatives and educational program development including such matters as opioid dependence and expanded scope of practice (ie. administration of injections, test ordering, and prescribing). The successful candidate will also serve as a staff resource to related College Committees, and review pharmacist and pharmacy technician applications in accordance with legislative requirements.

Key attributes of the Practice Consultant are effective communication skills (both verbal and written) and an excellent interpersonal skillset. The ideal candidate is a committed and motivated professional who works well both independently and collaboratively, possesses the ability to prioritize effectively and is committed to continuously expand their knowledge and skills to enhance personal and team innovation and productivity. A pharmacist presently licensed or eligible to be licensed in Manitoba with a minimum of five years of pharmacy practice experience in Canada would be preferred.

Located in Winnipeg, the College offers an attractive workplace and competitive wage and benefits package. Annual salary for this position will be commensurate with education, experience and skills.
