Bonnie Schultz Memorial Award for Pharmacy Practice Excellence

Patient Safety Award

The Patient Safety Award recognizes the achievement of an individual pharmacist, a group of pharmacists, an interdisciplinary group (that includes a pharmacist or pharmacists as key participants) or a pharmacy organization that has made a significant and lasting contribution to improving patient safety and health care quality through a specific initiative or project.

Criteria to be identified with the nomination should include:

- The pharmacist(s) involved are members of the College.
- The project or program has demonstrated a positive impact upon patient safety and involves some component of the practice of pharmacy.
- Innovation and patient-centred care projects will be given preference.
- The project or program could be preventative in nature, or may have occurred as a result of an adverse event or “near-miss”.
