

## **How to Stream Live Webcast Professional Development Programs**



## Step One: Register with sbrcstream.ca


Live webcast programs are hosted by SBRC on their website and you must register with sbrcstream.ca to access them. If you have already registered with sbrcstream.ca, please proceed to Step Two.

Registering with sbrcstream.ca allows you to log-in. When you log-in to sbrcstream.ca, you can participate fully in the live-streaming experience by posting comments or questions that can be shared with the speaker and the audience.

- 2. Click the 'Register' tab in the upper right corner of the screen:




3. Fill out the pop-up registration form and click 'Register:'




## Step Two: Log-In to sbrcstream.ca

1. Log-in to sbrcstream.ca with the unique username and password you created when you registered:



## Step Three: Open the Live Webcast Screen

Once you have logged-in to sbrcstream.ca, click on the 'Live Events' tab.



During a live webcast, you have the opportunity to communicate to other participants and the speaker by sending comments "privately" or "publicly". To direct questions to the speaker, begin your comment with the word, "Question" and send it publicly. Speakers will view and respond to questions at the end of the presentation.
